

Carriage

Carriages and Carriage Parts - There are 4 sizings of hook type fork carriages rated by the blade carriage hoisting capacity. Hook type tine carriages have been uniform.

Class I carriages are rated for loads as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for cargo up to 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is 25 inches.

The carriages for pin type tines can be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted tines could differ by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the tine. Carriage capacity will be established by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
